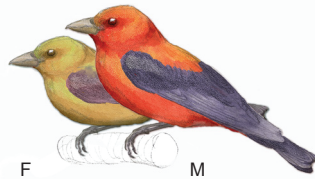
The following birds are listed in order of how frequently they occur in Greater Grant Park. Some species like the Northern Cardinal, Cedar Waxwing and Carolina Wren occur all year while the other species only travel through the city during the spring and summer months.<sup>1</sup>

The majority of these birds can be found anywhere where there are moderately spaced trees including but not limited to; Millennium Park's tree covered plazas, Peanut Park, Maggie Daley Park, in and around the Museum campus, along the lakefront bike path and near 12th Street Beach.<sup>2</sup> During summer months these birds are most active in mornings and evenings. During Cooler months, year-round species occur throughout the day.

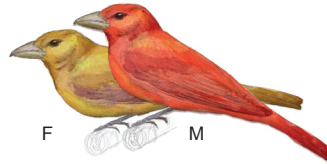

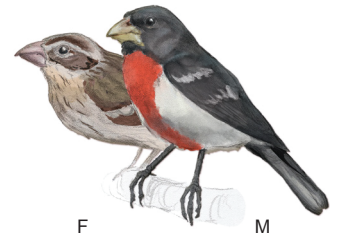

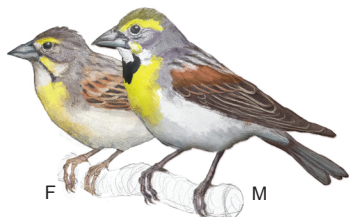
